14. Hiking Trail



As you walk on the original Unicoi Path (Unicoi Turnpike) in the Cherokee National Forest at Coker Creek you will follow the footsteps of people who traveled this path for centuries. The trail is 2 ½ miles long and runs between Unicoi Gap and Doc Rogers Fields. It is marked with a blue blaze. Modern explorers will pass by the marker for the murdered toll gate keeper, the remnants of Rolling Stone CCC Camp. Hikers should carry water, insect repellent, and a first aid kit. There is no cell phone signal on the trail. Stop by the Coker Creek Welcome Center for a free Unicoi Turnpike Trail Hiking Map.
